FY 2026 Services

- Laurel House, Inc. provided services to **981 individuals**.
- Counselors meet with program participants in-person, at the Resource Center and in the community, and also offer sessions virtually.
- **3,231 requests** for help were responded to by two rtor.org Resource Specialists. There were **1.1 million engagements** on www.rtor.org.

FY 2026 Outcomes

Supported Education

- 140 participants: 20% in Associate's; 16% in Bachelor's; 16% in Vocational Certification; 13% in GED; 2% in Master's; 33% in high school and alternative schools
- Onsite at college campuses and high schools

Supported Employment

- 160 participants: 70% competitively employed and 79% with sustained employment over 24 months

Mobile Employment Services (MES)

- 69 participants with substance use disorders received onsite service at Recovery Houses

Thinking Well (Cognitive Remediation)

- 131 participants: 100% who completed sessions and took post-assessment achieved improvement in at least 1 of 5 domains; 88% in 2 domains; 64% in 3; 36% in 4 of 5; and 16% improved in all domains
- 50 participants found a job and 42 enrolled in an education program

Community Support Services and Housing

- 98 participants received support services and housing: case management and counseling in recovery planning; Activities of Daily Living (ADLs); and budgeting

Social Rehabilitation/Skill Building

- 851 individuals received services in: Writers', Artists' and Skill Building Workshops; recovery planning, outreach, advocacy, peer support and wellness programs, including food delivery to participants
